The public is invited to attend the free annual Summer Reading Program Kick-Off, Saturday, June 11 at 2pm at the Main Library.

One World, Many Stories is the theme of the Summer Reading Program and runs from June 13 through July 23. Children will be encouraged to learn more about the world through crafts, stories and other fun activities.

Students, pre-school through 12th grade may register for the Summer Reading Program at the Kick-Off.

Through June 11, children in pre-school through 3rd grade must pledge to read a minimum of 6 books at their listening or reading level. Those in 4th through 8th grade, must pledge to read a minimum of 4 books and those in 9th through 12th grade, a minimum of 3 books. Incentives and certificates will be given after the participant completes the number of books pledged.

Patrons are encouraged to pick-up sign-up sheets and rules available at all units.
